

How to Read Your Meter



Look for a box like this - usually located at the front of the property.



This sweep hand registers each gallon. Every complete revolution is ten gallons. You will be able to determine how much water is being used per minute.

This red indicator will tell you that water is running. If everything is turned off and this indicator is moving - even very slowly - you are losing water somewhere.



This is the actual reading. The meter has a fixed zero, measuring in tens of gallons. For every revolution of the sweep hand, the digit next to the fixed zero will register. If you check this before you water and again immediately after, you will have a good idea of how much water you are using in your yard.
